This November, after my HMA, I will be moving back to Phnom Penh to minister to college students and young adults. The specifics of my role aren't set yet but I plan to focus on discipleship with men from the local church, help a dorm ministry, and possibly work with a new church plant. It is an exciting but bittersweet opportunity because I will have to say goodbye to everyone in the village but some good news is that our village and city ministries are very integrated so I will see the students again when they graduate and come to Phnom Penh for college!

Please keep me in prayer as I discuss with my team how I can best serve the church in Phnom Penh. I will send updates as I figure out more specifically what my new role will look like so keep posted.
